

RULES FOR KETTING NOR

Fishing permits.

The date specified on the fishing permit is the first date of validity. Day permits are valid from 00:00 to 24:00 (24h clock). Weekend permits are valid Saturday + Sunday. Weekly permits are valid Monday through Sunday.

Fishing permits are strictly personal and not transferable.

Violation of "Rules for Ketting Nor" will lead to immediate expulsion.

Accessibility and traffic in the area.

Ketting Nor is a bird sanctuary and therefore a protected area.

Parking is only allowed on the designated parking space.

Traffic in the area with utmost consideration to animals and plants, as well as to the other visitors.

Traffic must also be in accordance with Naturbeskyttelsesloven (the Nature Protection Act), including Bekendtgørelse om offentlighedens adgang til at færdes og opholde sig i naturen (the Executive Order on public access to nature).

Access to the fishing grounds from the path on the south side of the lake respectively from the sluice in the west end of the lake. Do not walk in other areas of the reed beds. Bonfires are forbidden.

Closed seasons and minimum sizes.

Perch	20 cm	
Brown-, sea- and lake trout	40 cm	November 16 to February 15
Eel	45 cm	

All dates are in the close season.

Fishing, bag limits etc.

Fishing permit and if required fishing license must be carried during fishing and presented upon request.

Fishing is allowed on app. 500 m on the south side of the lake and on both sides of the channel. See map.

Fishing is allowed with one (1) rod only.

The use ground bait or live bait is not allowed.

Introducing of fish is not allowed.

Fishing is allowed around the clock, except April, May and June, where fishing is allowed from sunrise to sunset.

Waste.

Littering is prohibited.
